Create a poster advertising the outdoor activity centre from *Mondays are murder*.


Design an alternative front cover for the book that you are currently reading.

Mathematics

In maths this half term we are learning about place value and will be learning formal written methods of multiplication and division. We introduce these with concrete resources. Examples will be included in the maths homework book when it is sent home.

Children need to know all of their times tables and I would like them to keep practising them at home either through flashcards or using Hit the Button. If you want to challenge your child you can ask them to try learn how to convert between fractions, decimals & percentages.
