Miss Mitchell will have a non-class based role to enable her to focus on her leadership responsibilities in support of the school moving forward.

Transition morning is a good opportunity for your child to work with their new class teacher. Before they go, they will write a piece of work to share with their teacher to show what they can achieve and they will complete calculations in order to show their preferred methods. Transition meetings will have taken place in order to aid a smooth transition for your child to the next class. During the morning's transition, there will be an opportunity for them to start setting class agreements and to learn more about the coming year.

As we did last year, we will hold meetings for parents to meet the class teachers in the first couple of weeks of school. I appreciate that it is difficult for everyone to attend a meeting at 3 pm, therefore I will ensure a leaflet is sent home providing details. This will give you an early opportunity to get to know the class teacher, to learn about year group expectations and for the teacher to meet you.
