


Topic

Mathematics

In maths this half term we are learning about place value and will be developing methods of how to use our knowledge in addition and subtraction. We introduce this with concrete resources. Homework will be set on this topic. We will also be focusing on mental arithmetic, can you support your child by practising mental addition and subtraction?

Please encourage multiplication as much as possible. Children need to be fluent in their 2, 5 and 10 times tables by the end of Key Stage 1. We would also like them to learn the 3 times tables.

Telling the time is a key skill for children and we would appreciate if you could use opportunities to discuss the time and ask children to tell the time in everyday situations.

Mymaths homework will be set every week.



English

In English this half term we will be looking at the traditional tale, Stone Soup. Can you perform the story for your family? It has many different forms from lots of countries, can you research this? Can you write a report on your findings to share with the class?

Reading

Remember, your reading book can be changed everyday so make sure it is signed and brought to school! It is important to bring your book every day as we will read them in school as well.
