Can you design an outfit for a poor person to wear in Victorian times?


Can you find a recipe of something that would have been eaten in Victorian times and make it? If you don't want to bring it in you can always take a picture.

Mathematics

In maths this half term we will be exploring algebra and looking how it is often used in our daily lives. Furthermore, we will also be looking at co-ordinates & continue to look at 3D shapes and nets.

Can you draw a 3D shape and try to create a net for it?

Can you answer the following questions?

$$A + 23 = 17 + 6$$

$$B \times 9 = 81$$

$$C - 12 = 18 + 17$$

$$D \times 12 = 36 \times 2$$

$$E - 2 \times 14 = 30$$

You can present all of this work in your maths homework book for me to look at and mark.

Please continue to encourage multiplication practice as much as possible as it underpins a lot of the maths in Year 6.

Children need to know all of their times tables and I would like them to keep practising them at home either through flashcards or using Hit the Button.

My Maths homework will be set every week.

English
