# Mathematics

In Maths we will be looking at converting fractions to decimals. Any practise with this at home would be fantastic. We will also be looking at finding the area and perimeter of shapes. Can you measure the perimeter of your living room? Can you work out the area of it?

Telling the time is a key skill for children and it would be fantastic if you could use opportunities to discuss the time and ask children to tell the time in everyday situations. You could also ask them to convert the time from the 12 to 24 hour time.

Please encourage multiplication as much as possible. Children need to know all their times tables by the end of this year.
