Mathematics

This half term we will continue to consolidate place value, addition (+) and subtraction (-). We still need to practise our counting to and from 100. It is tricky but can you practise this at home? Can you count in 2s, 5s and 10s too?

You all have a numberline to use at home. Could you write your own + and - number sentences to practise 'jumping before you count'? Try to use numbers under 0 - 50 for now.

We will begin to look at multiplication (x) using arrays.

We will also be learning how to measure volume of liquids. Can you practise using measuring jugs at home?



English

This term we will look at some fantastic books about changes that happen around us. One book we will read is called 'Tadpole's Promise'. Can you research tadpoles? It would also be brilliant if you could keep practising your handwriting at home? It really does help us to write our letters the right way round and it helps us to get faster!
