



## **EAST BIERLEY CE(VC) PRIMARY SCHOOL**

### **Sports Premium Funding 2016-17**

#### **What is it?**

The government have set aside money to spend on improving the quality of sports and PE in all Primary schools. This money is jointly provided by the Department for Education, Health and Culture, Media and Sports.

At East Bierley we receive £8,000 per annum and £5 per pupil (From Year 1-6).

This funding is used to ensure all our pupils have access to high quality PE, develop healthy lifestyles and it promotes engagement in PE and sports.

#### **How will it be spent?**

At East Bierley we plan to spend our Sports Premium funding on:

- Staff development – through high quality CPD to enable staff to teach high quality PE lessons and provide opportunities for our children. This CPD will enable the quality of PE lessons to be improved and sustainable and is required as coaches have taught most PE in recent years. A full review of the PE curriculum and sport review will ensure teachers receive CPD in aspects of the PE curriculum where they feel they will benefit the most for training which will take place in the autumn and spring terms.
- Affiliation to a Gold package offered by the Accelerate Team at Tong High School. Accelerate provide many opportunities to compete against other local schools, level 2, and a pathway to lead to competitions at West Yorkshire level, level 3. This provides opportunities for children to try a wide range of sporting activities and to work as part of a team. This ran from April 2016 until December 2016 in the stated format. Some competitions still planned to occur following that date and we will complete in them as per our qualification to events.
- Improvements to the organisation and training of Young Leaders (Playleaders) in both key stages to ensure high quality play during play and lunchtimes for all children and opportunities for sports leadership. This is sustainable as the resources and the training programme used are within school. Training was provided using PE co-ordinator time funded by the Sports premium funding. It is sustainable as over time children will be able to lead the training of the next play leaders and all children entering school will be joining a school where active play and lunchtimes are encouraged and facilitated. Two year groups were trained in July 2016 (the year 2 and Year5 children as they will be the oldest children out during their playtimes from September. Building their skills and confidence will include the older play leaders undertaking a lead role during our Key Stage 1 sports day in the summer.
- Providing additional out of school sports coaching and subsidising the costs involved.
- The PE co-ordinator has some additional hours to plan, organise and administrate a comprehensive competition framework and opportunities within school. By developing interhouse sports within school, linked to sports covered through the PE curriculum will enable a wider group of children to participate in competitive sports and therefore is sustainable. This will be developed with the local high school many of our children attend and their Level 1 accredited pupils will help organise and run events showing the lasting legacy of the premium funding. Utilising resources at the local High School and working with them to build that legacy.

- Some transportation costs to attend competition at venues such as Futsal Arena, Leeds; Richard Dunns Sports Centre, Bradford; and Leeds Beckett's University.
- From January 2017, CPD and additional sports camps are being provided by Velocity Coaching. The additional planned sports camp is subsidised from the funding and is a trial to look at future out of school camps.
- Providing new resources.

Sports Activities from April, provided through the competition package. All children have had the opportunity to develop skills in new sports and some children to compete against other schools. All children compete within school. Events include:
