- Are detained under the Mental Health Act 1983 during your period of office;
- Have been removed from a charity trusteeship by the Charity Commissioners or High Court on the grounds of misconduct or mismanagement;
- Are included in the list of teachers or workers prohibited or restricted from working with children and young persons (currently named List 99);
- Have been disqualified from being an independent school proprietor, teacher or employee in any school by an Independent School Tribunal or the Secretary of State;
- Have in the previous five years (or since becoming a governor) been sentenced to three months or more in prison (whether suspended or not) without the option of a fine;
- Have in the previous 20 years been sentenced to imprisonment for two and a half years or more;
- Have at any time been sentenced to imprisonment for five years or more;
- Have been fined for causing a nuisance or disturbance on school premises during the five years prior to, or since, appointment or election as a Governor.
- Bankruptcy- If your estate has been sequestrated and the sequestration has not been discharged, annulled or reduced; or is the subject of a bankruptcy restrictions order or an interim order.
