



EAST BIERLEY CE (VC) PRIMARY SCHOOL Sports Premium Funding 2017-18

What is it?

The government have set aside money to spend on improving the quality of sports and PE in all Primary schools. This money is jointly provided by the Department for Education, Health and Culture, Media and Sports.

At East Bierley we receive £16,000 per annum and £10 per pupil (From Year 1-6).

This funding is used to ensure all our pupils have access to high quality PE, develop healthy lifestyles and it promotes engagement in PE and sports.

How will it be spent?

At East Bierley we plan to spend our Sports Premium funding on:

- Staff development – through high quality CPD to enable staff to lead high quality PE lessons and provide opportunities for our children. This CPD will enable the quality of PE lessons to be improved and sustainable and is required as sports coaches have taught most of our PE in recent years. A full review of the PE curriculum and sport review will ensure teachers receive CPD in aspects of the PE curriculum where they feel they will benefit the most. Training will take place in the autumn and spring terms.
- From January 2017, CPD and additional sports camps are being provided by Velocity Coaching. The additional planned sports camp is subsidised from the funding and is a trial to look at the future of our school camps. This provides opportunities for children to try a wide range of sporting activities and to work as part of a team.
- Affiliation to a competitive sports programme offered by the Accelerate Team at Tong High School. Also, Velocity provide many opportunities to compete against other local schools. These opportunities are at level 2, with a pathway to lead to competitions at West Yorkshire level, level 3. This provides occasions for children to try a wide range of sporting activities and to work as part of a team. This ran from September 2016 and will cease in July 2017. Some competitions are still planned to occur in the summer term of 2017.
- Improvements to the organisation and training of Young Leaders (Play Leaders) in both key stages to ensure high quality play during play and lunchtimes for all children and opportunities for sports leadership. This is sustainable as the resources and the training programme used are within school.
- Providing additional out of school sports coaching and subsidising the costs involved.
- Some transportation costs to attend competition at venues such as Temple Newsam, Richard Dunns Sports Centre, Bradford and Leeds Beckett University.
- Providing new resources.
- The opportunity to develop skills in new sports and some for children to complete against other schools.
- Competing in Enrichment afternoons (every third Wednesday for each class) which gives children the opportunity to take part in competitive games and try new sports which they may not normally access.

Our long term aim at East Bierley Primary School is for all children to be healthy, active and willing to participate in quality PE lessons provided at school.

Pupil voice:

During discussion children across both KS1 and KS2 spoke positively about the range of opportunities they have to take part in sporting competitions; either during 'Enrichment afternoons' or participation of the cross country when the whole of Upper KS 2 participated in this Level One sporting event.

"I love it when Mr Heath announces the winner of the sport cup on a Friday afternoon – my team (Yellow team) has only won it once though" – Year 5 child.

"My favourite part of the week is competitive sports on a Wednesday afternoon – we once did a whole afternoon playing tri- golf. I think I might go and play at the local golf club now" – Year 6 child.

"Sport is so fun at our school" – Year 2 child.

"We get to do a lot of different sports at our school. My class gets to go swimming EVERY Monday" – Year 4 child.

All children compete within school. These events include:
