<u>Knowledge Organisers</u>

Each term we will send home an overview of our next topic. This overview will include some key vocabulary and things to think about and discuss with your child. There may be fun facts or challenges to do together.

<u>Settling in</u>

This term will be focussing on settling into Reception and learning new routines and rules. Children will be expected to:

- Use kind words to speak to their friends and adults, including please and thank you.
- Tidy up after themselves.
- Become independent at dressing, including coats and shoes.
- Use a knife and fork to eat lunch independently.
