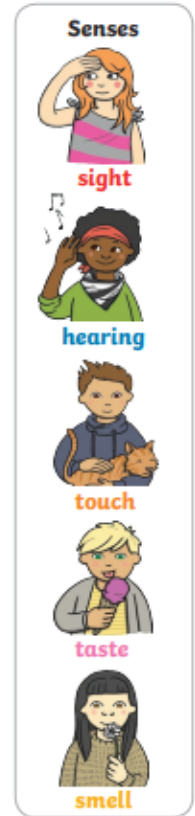
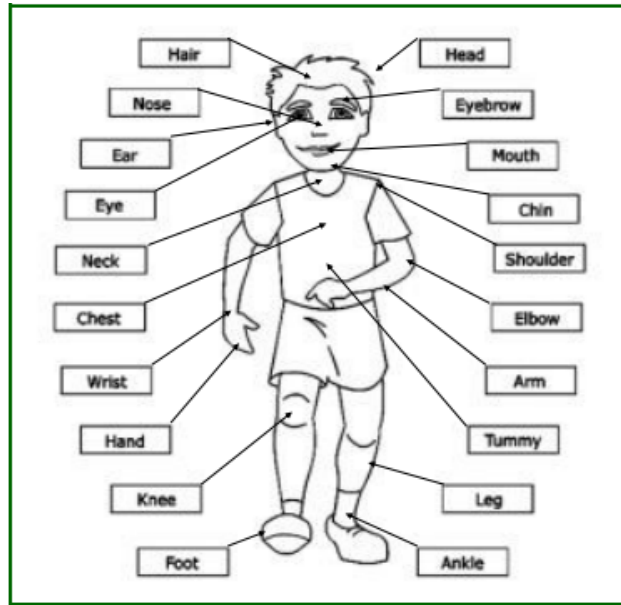

Animal Groups

Animal Group	Definition
Mammals	Animals that grow hair or fur and feed on their mother's milk as a baby.
Fish	An animal with gills and fins that lives in water.
Amphibians	Animals that live in the water as babies and on land as they grow older. They have smooth, slimy skin.
Reptiles	An animal which has dry, scaly skin and lays eggs on land.
Birds	An animal with feathers, wings and a beak. They are usually able to fly.
Invertebrates	Animals with no back bone.

	Definition
 Carnivore	Animals that mostly eat other animals (meat).
 Omnivore	Animals that eat plants and other animals.
 Herbivore	Animals that only eat plants.
