

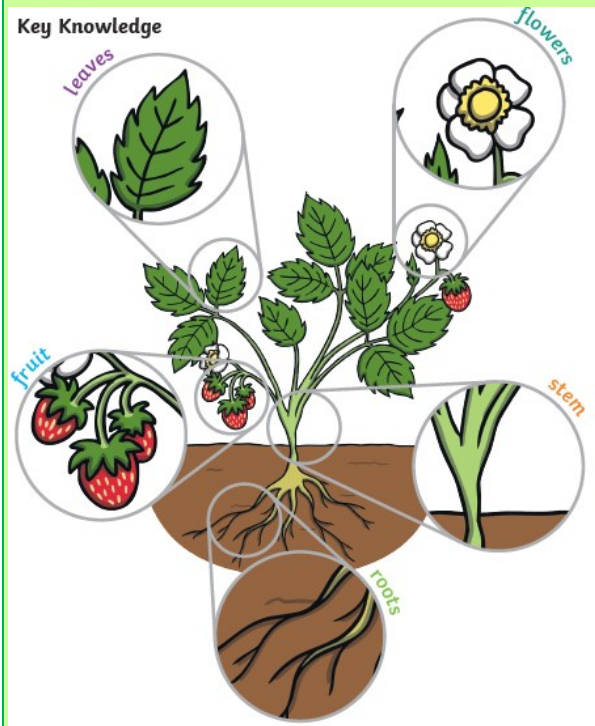

## Structure of a Flowering Plant

A **plant** is a living thing which grows in the earth.

A typical structure of a flowering plant looks like this



**Garden plants** are plants that people choose to grow in their gardens.



**Wild plants** grow where their seeds fall. They don't need to be planted or cared for as they grow.



**Weeds** are wild plants that grown in places where people don't want them.

A plant may grow from a **bulb** or a **seed**.

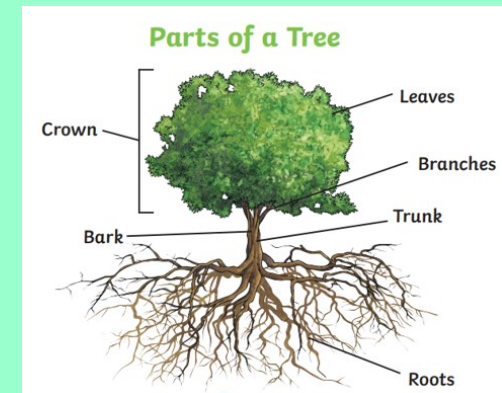


## Trees

**Deciduous trees** lose their leaves each year.

**Evergreen trees** keep their leaves all year round, even in winter.
