English:

To begin this term we are going to be reading and then writing our own poems, thinking about bonfire night and the autumn season. The books we will then look at are The Traction Man and The Robot and The Blue Bird. We we work on character and setting descriptions from these books still remembering capital letters, finger spaces and full stops.



PSHE:

We look relationships. We start with family and friendships. Then respecting ourselves and others and then finally the importance of safe relationships.



Science:

This term we are looking at different materials. We look at a range of objects and the materials they are made from like wood, plastic etc. We then also look at freezing and melting along with sinking or floating.



Computing:

This term we are looking at algorithms unplugged. This is all about following and setting steps/instructions. We will look at crossing the road, drawing a picture, making food and other instructions. We will read codes and debug directions.



R.E:

We are continuing our RE topic 'Why are festivals important and why do we celebrate them'. Once we have finished this we will begin looking at the importance of special stories and books.



PE:

We start this term by focusing on dance. We create our dance to the song 'I just cant wait to be king' from The Lion King. We then move onto tennis for the last few weeks of the term working on the skills of hitting and throwing. In PE with Mr Myers the children will complete a range of competitive games.

Geography:

Our focus this term is where we live. We start by looking at where East Bierley is and what we know about it. We look on at maps to find places and give directions to move around. We then focus on the 4 countries in the UK and the seas around it.



Art:

We are experimenting with different techniques and media this term by looking at the details of autumn leaves.



Maths:

- Recognise, naming and sorting 3D shapes.
- Recognise, naming and sorting 2D shapes.
- Adding and subtraction up to 20
- Doubling.
- Relating number facts.
- Place value from 20 to 50.



We will be learning:

- What it was like for those who lived in the Stone age to Iron age.
- To locate significant and local Stone to Iron age sites on a map.
- To study how geography of locality influenced life including diet.
- To create cave paintings and Stone Age tools
- To investigate rocks in Science and learn how fossils are formed.
- To compose writing inspired by the Stone Age.
